Certificate in Teaching in the Lifelong Learning Sector

This professional course is the second stage of training for those wishing to teach/train adults. It is a City & Guilds requirement that students must be teaching/training for at least 30 hours for the duration of the course.



What previous knowledge, experience, and skills do I need?

Candidates should be adequately qualified in the subject they intend to teach by virtue of holding an appropriate professional or other qualification.

Candidates should also have successfully completed the Preparing to Teach in the Lifelong Learning Sector course (PTLLS) at Level 3 or Level 4, or should hold the City & Guilds 7407 stage 1 qualification.

A good level of literacy is required at the outset of the course to ensure candidates' ability to complete written assignment work.

What subjects will I study?

The Course can be completed at Level 3 or Level 4 qualification with City and Guilds examining body.

The course includes the following units:

Unit 2: Planning and Enabling Learning

Unit 3: Principles and Practice of assessment

Unit 9: Managing Behaviour in the Learning Environment

What commitment must I make?

Students will be given a reading list and regular assignments to complete, with deadlines to follow. You will be expected to do at least 6 hours of theoretical study each week.

What can I do once I've finished the course?

This is the entry qualification which allows progression to the 7305 Diploma in Teaching in the Lifelong Learning Sector.

How much does the course cost?

The course costs £477 full fee or £150 concession. If your employer is paying for you, please note that the invoiced fee is 50% more than the subsidised standard fee. For more information, please ask the centre for details.

What financial help can I receive?

Some students may be eligible to receive financial assistance from our Bursary Fund, which can contribute to the cost of books and childcare.

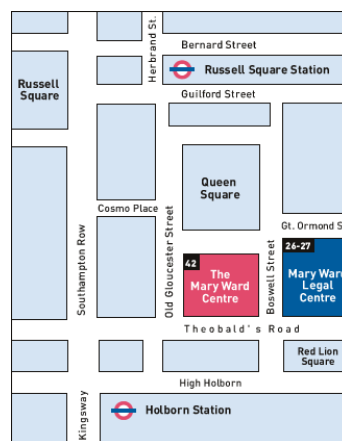
Full attendance is essential.
