Course dates and structure

This course is for qualified and experienced counsellors and therapists who wish to develop their skills as a clinical supervisor. You need to be working as a supervisor or have secured a placement as a supervisor in order to do this course. The 90 hours training runs over thirteen Saturdays and one weekend in central London.

The structure of the day is that the morning sessions will be theoretical looking at an aspect of supervision theory and the afternoons will be practical. These sessions will consist of case presentations of supervision sessions and live supervision of a peer.

The thematic aspects discussed will include:

1. models of supervision
2. working within the professional framework as a supervisor
3. understanding basic group dynamics within supervision, including transference and countertransference

4. Ethical and legal aspects of supervision
5. Working with diversity in supervision
6. Assessment in supervision.
7. Creative approaches to supervision.

We use a variety of teaching and learning methods, which will include some didactic input but also group discussion, role plays, commenting on case presentations and observing supervision sessions.

### Assessment

Assessment will be internal and external. Internal assessment will be both ongoing and with a final assessment of live supervision with a peer in June 2020. You will also be expected to produce a portfolio of written work (which include essays and learning journal extracts, notes on supervision practice etc ) as part of your work on the course.

The external assessment comprises of a case review which is externally assessed by the awarding body the CPCAB .

Additional supervision of supervision.

You will need to have five hours of supervision of your supervision practice outside of the course hours. This can be either individual or in a group . You will have to pay for this additional to the course fees.

### Qualification

On successful completion of the internal and external aspects of the course you will receive the Level 6 Certificate in Therapeutic Counselling Supervision by the CPCAB awarding body. This will enable you to practice as a clinical supervisor.
