


LEVEL 3: DIPLOMA IN COUNSELLING SKILLS (CACHE/NCFE)

For those who have completed an approved level 2 course or its equivalent. The course includes theory, practical skills, personal development work, a compulsory weekend component and a minimum attendance requirement of 80%. Validated by CACHE/NCFE, it meets the entry requirements for the level 4 Professional Diploma in Integrative Counselling. Entry is by written application and group and individual interview. LEVEL 4: PROFESSIONAL DIPLOMA IN INTEGRATIVE COUNSELLING (CPCAB)

A challenging two-year course qualifying you to practise as a counsellor in an agency. Drawing on Clarkson's five-strand model of the therapeutic relationship, the course integrates humanistic, analytic and transpersonal perspectives. Students will be expected to have 70 hours of personal counselling and to begin a counselling placement. Entry onto the course is by interview, and you must already have a minimum of 180 hours formal counselling training or the equivalent. The fees stated are for the entire two-year course.
